# We want to make sure you get every tax credit and deduction you're entitled to.

So, before you get started on your taxes, make sure you have all the receipts and income records you need.

### Slips

- o T4 slips (Employment income)
- o Employment insurance benefits (T4A or T4E)
- o COVID-19 relief payments or repayments (T4A)
- o Interest, dividends, mutual funds (T3,T5,T5008)
- o T2202 Tuition and Enrollment Certificate
- Old Age Security and CPP benefits (T4A-OAS, T4AP)
- o Other pensions and annuities (T4A,T4RSP, T4RIF)
- o Social assistance payments (T5007)
- o Worker's compensation benefits (T5007)
- o All other information slips

### Receipts

- o RRSP contribution receipts
- o Support for a child, spouse or common-law partner
- o Professional or union dues
- o Tool expenses (Tradespersons & apprentice mechanics)
- o Office-in-home expenses (if working at home due to COVID)
- o Other employment expenses
- o Teacher's school supplies
- o Medical expenses
- o Home renovations (seniors & disabled)
- Charitable donations
- o Political contributions

### Receipts (continued)

- o Childcare expenses
- Adoption expenses
- O Moving expenses
- o Interest paid on student loans
- o Carrying charges &interest expenses
- o Exams for professional certification
- o Digital news subscription
- o Labour Mobility Deduction for Tradespeople
